### **QUESTION 5**

A company currently has two F80 RS/6000s running AIX 4.3.3. They plan on purchasing a pSeries partitionable server for consolidation and future expansion. What steps should be taken to migrate their F80s to a new system?

A. Install LPAR with AIX from CD, create a tar tape with user data and install in LPAR, recompile all 32-bit applications.

B. Validate applications run on AIX 5.1 Maintenance Level 1, migrate F80s to AIX 5.1, create mksysb, restore in LPAR using NIM image.

C. Validate applications run on AIX 5.1 Maintenance Level 1, create a mksysb of the F80s, restore in LPAR using NIM image, upgrade LPAR to AIX 5.1.
