#### **QUESTION 2**

The second group, NETWORK, requires access to the same tools used by the OPERATIONS group users. In addition, there are a few tools used for advanced router diagnostics that they use. These tools are not to be available to the OPERATIONS group users. To minimize administration efforts a common desktop menu is used for both groups of users.

The RouterDiag tool, used by NETWORK users, is defined in a menu called DiagTools. The tool is only used for Acme routers. The Acme routers produce SNMP traps, which are converted to events by the MTTrapd probe.
