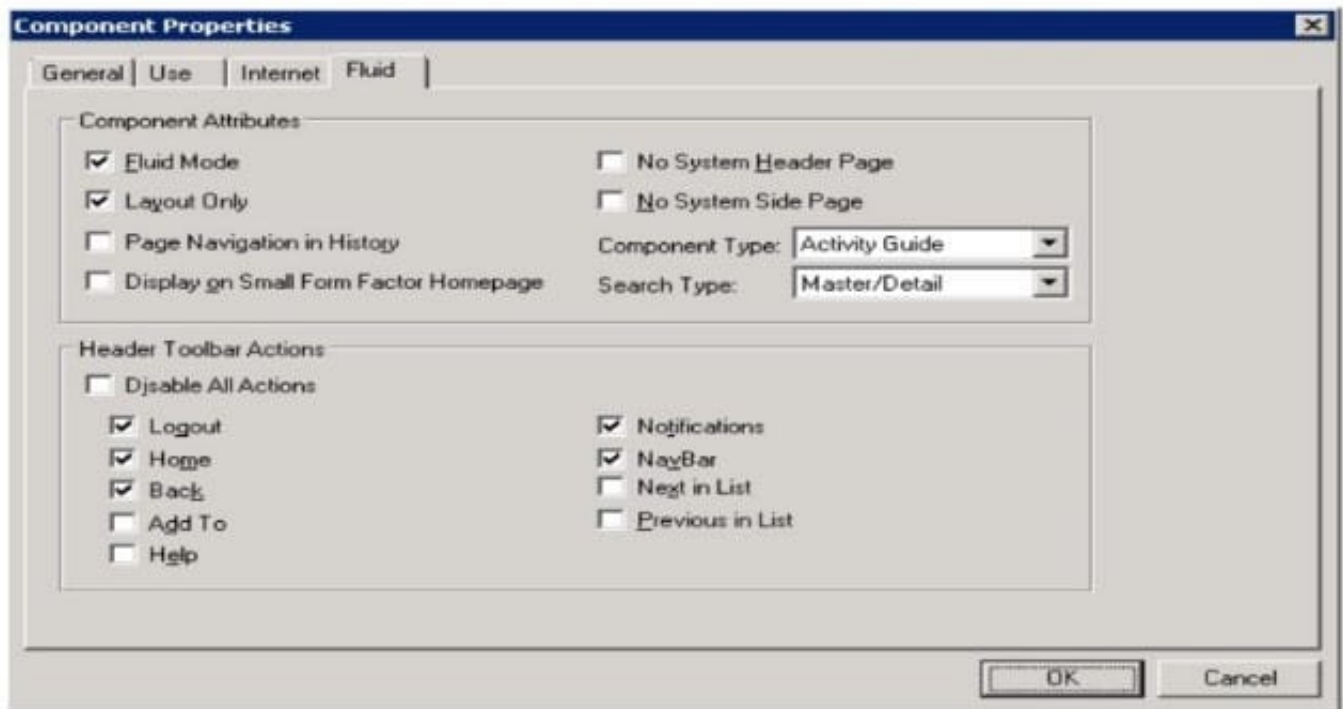
How would you create this field?
