**QUESTION 5**

Upon rendering a composition, you would like After Effects to automatically replace a source item in your project with the new render. What is the most efficient way to do this?

- A. set the Post Action render to "Set Proxy" in the Output module and click OK, then press Render, once the render is complete, press the little square icon next to the composition in the Project panel
- B. set the Post Action render to "None" in the Output module, click OK, and press Render, once the render is complete, select the file you wish to replace in the Project panel and choose File > Replace Footage > File
- C. set the Post-Render Action to "Import and Replace Footage" in the Output Module and click OK, then twirl down the Output Module in the Render Queue, and drag the pick whip to the item to be replaced in the Project panel to specify it, then press Render
- D. set the Post-Render Action to "Import" in the Output Module, click OK, and press Render, once the render is complete, select the item you wish to replace in the timeline panel, and drag the new footage from the Project panel while holding down ALT or OPTION onto that layer in the timeline
