Correct Answer: CD

The errors related to documents are listed in the Preflight panel. To know about errors in a document, open the Preflight panel in one of the following ways:

1. Choose Window > Output > Preflight.
 2. Double-click the Preflight icon at the bottom of document window. To view image errors, expand the '\\Image and Object\\' menu. To view information about specific errors, click the error in the error pane. A description appears in the Info pane at the bottom of the Preflight panel along with suggestions to fix the error.

QUESTION 2

You are a regular user of InDesign CS5. You want to locate any imported color bitmapped image with an effective resolution of less than 260 ppi. What will you do to accomplish this task?

- A. Using the Preflight panel, edit the Basic profile using a Color Image Minimum Resolution setting of 260 ppi.
- B. Using the Preflight panel, create a new Preflight profile with a Color Image Minimum Resolution setting of 260 ppi.
- C. Using the Preflight panel, edit the Basic profile using a Color Image Maximum Resolution setting of 260 ppi.
- D. Using the Preflight panel, create a new Preflight profile with a Color Image Maximum Resolution setting of 260 ppi.

Correct Answer: B

To locate any imported color bitmapped image with an effective resolution of less than 260 ppi, you will create a new Preflight profile with a Color Image Minimum Resolution setting of 260 ppi in the Preflight panel.

QUESTION 3

What will you do if you want to place crop marks 8 mm from the trim edge when printing?

- A. Choose File > Document Setup > Click the More Options button, and enter 8 mm as the Slug value.



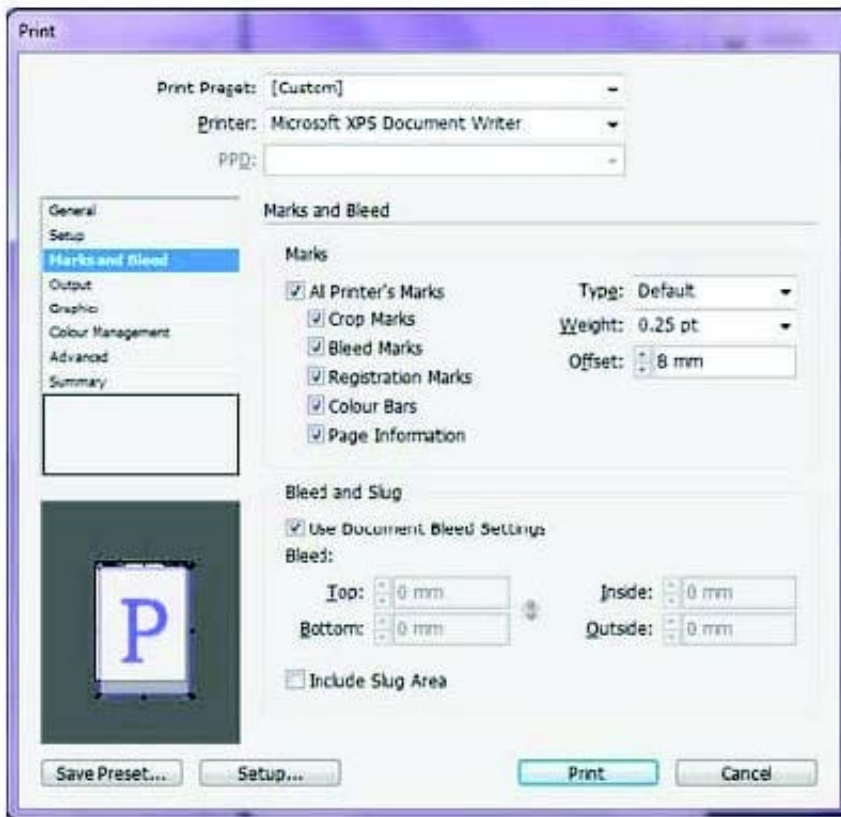
B. Select the All Printer's Marks checkbox in the Marks and Bleed pane of the Print Dialog Box and set the Offset field to 8 mm.

C. Uncheck Use Document Bleed Settings and enter values from 0 to 6 inches for Top, Bottom, Left, and Right for single-sided documents.

D. Uncheck Use Document Bleed Settings and enter values from 0 to 6 inches for Top, Bottom, Inside, and Outside for double-sided documents with facing pages.

Correct Answer: B

If you want to place crop marks 8 mm from the trim edge while printing, you will Select the All Printer's Marks checkbox in the Marks and Bleed pane of the Print Dialog Box, and set the Offset field to 8 mm.

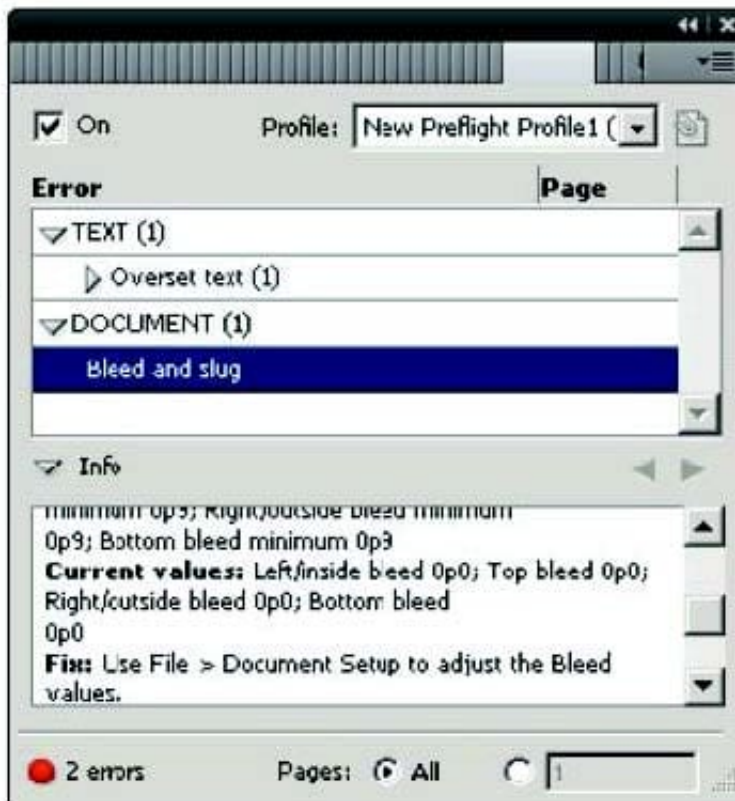
QUESTION 5

You work as a Design Expert for company Inc. You are creating a document. The document is showing the Bleed and slug error in the error pane of the Preflight panel. You want to know the solution to fix this problem. What will you do?

- A. Double Click to expand the Document menu and then click on the red dot in the lower-right corner of the Preflight panel.
- B. Double Click to expand the Document menu in the Preflight panel and then click the error in question.
- C. Double Click to expand the Document menu in the Preflight panel and then click the Info pane.
- D. Click on the icon on the left side from the profile pop menu in the Preflight panel.

Correct Answer: B

To view document errors, double click to expand the Document menu and to view information about specific errors such as in the above scenario the Bleed and slug error, click the error in question. appear in the Info pane at the bottom of the Preflight panel along with suggestions to fix the error as shown in the figure given below:



Answer: C is incorrect. Although the Info pane at the bottom of the Preflight panel contains the description of the error and the solution to fix that problem, if you double Click to expand the Document menu in the Preflight panel and then click the Info pane, it will not show the document error because this is not the right way to see the description of the error. Answer: A is incorrect. If you double Click to expand the Document menu and then click on the red dot in the lower-right corner of the Preflight panel, nothing will happen. Answer: D is incorrect. If you click on the icon in the Preflight panel, it will embed the selected profile.
