- C. On the Property Definition tab, create a new property definition and for the Type, select "dataInterface" from the complex types. In the XPage,select the custom control, then go to the Custom Properties

section, click the Computed Property Icon and type in "return document2;".

D. On the Property Definition tab, create a new property definition and for the Type, select "Domino Document" from the complex types. In the XPage, select the custom control, then go to the Custom Properties section, click the the Computed Property Icon and type in "getComponent (document2\\').getValue();".
