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### QUESTION 1

- C. java.net.URL redirectURL - The login redirect URL.
- D. javax.security.auth.Subject subject - A security subject to be passed to the WebSphere Application Server login modules that can be null if not needed.

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### QUESTION 2

Tyson is the sole IBM WebSphere Portal administrator in his company. He has developed a portlet that uses content spots to bind certain portlet markup to users specific to a certain group accessing the portlet itself. What bindings can Tyson create to associate the users with the content spots to be shown?

- A. He can use Personalization Rules based on user and group information, hiding and showing the content spots per each grouping as desired.
- B. He can use the ContentPresentationModel to hide and show content spots based on any parameter included in the ContentPresentationResource and change the content spot based on the user's group
- C. He can store a personalization rule in the theme that creates a new version of the portlet for each user group automatically on first access, using the PortletClientModel and leveraging the PUMA UserGroup object
- D. Portlets cannot include dynamic content spots.

- C. The API provides person tags to custom portlets.
- D. The API provides the IBM Connections business cards capability to a custom portlet.

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#### QUESTION 4

Emery is trying to make it so users from a specific geographic location do not have access to a specific metrics application hosted on their IBM WebSphere Portal server. Which of the following options is provided within WebSphere Portal that Emery can use to this purpose?

- A. Emery can use the call to ensure the portlet is hidden for the geography to block.
- B. Emery can use Personalization Rules to hide the portlet, leveraging information in the user repository regarding the user's geographic location.
- C. Emery's users must register as being from a specific geography and Emery can develop workflow methods leveraging the PortalUserIdentityBean (or PUIB) object to ensure the portlet does not generate markup for the user in this geography.
- D. None of the above. Emery is going to need to create a page and assign metadata parameters to hide the specific portlet from users from geographies that are not allowed to see it.

- C. WSRP producer portlets cannot use IBM WebSphere Portal internals in portlets such as engine objects or engine tags.
- D. WSRP producer portlets do not support edit\_defaults\_compatibility portlet mode.
