Correct Answer: D

Team effectiveness is reflected in achievement of objectives, innovation, adaptability, commitment, and favorable evaluations by senior management. According to Hans Thamhain, team effectiveness is determined by three sets of interdependent factors. Team effectiveness requires that all factors need to be addressed continually. A high-performance team is committed to the personal growth of its team members.

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### QUESTION 3

What operations strategy is most likely to be adopted when the product sold by an organization is a commodity and the market is very large?

- A. Flexibility strategy.
- B. Quality strategy.
- C. Service strategy.
- D. Cost strategy.

Correct Answer: D



An operations strategy formulates a long-term plan for using enterprise resources to reach strategic objectives. A cost strategy is successful when the enterprise is the low-cost producer. However, the product (e.g., a commodity) tends to be undifferentiated in these cases, the market is often very large, and the competition tends to be intense because of the possibility of high-volume sales.

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#### QUESTION 4

Which of the following most accurately describes the purpose of application authentication controls?

- A. To ensure that data input into business applications is valid, complete, and accurate.
- B. To prevent or detect errors in data processed using business applications.
- C. To ensure that business applications are protected from unauthorized logical access.
