What should Peter do to recover the Sametime Community server?

- A. In the Domino console window, enter the command quit and restart the IBM Domino server which will also restart the IBM Sametime Community Server.
- B. Log into the Sametime System Console, navigate to Servers > WebSphere Application Servers and select the Sametime Community Server from the list and click Stop. Once the server completely stops, select it again and click Start.
- C. Open a command prompt, navigate to the Domino program directory and enter the command nsd -kill staddin to kill the Sametime Community server, then enter the command load staddin in the Domino console window which will restart it.
- D. In the Windows 2008 Service window, select the Community Services Launcher and stop the service. Once all the associated Sametime Services have stopped, restart the Community Services Launcher service which will then restart all the other Sametime Services.
