#### QUESTION 4

You must ensure that all records from the Customer table in the Alpha database are being moved to the Delta staging database using the audit logs. In the Local Object Library, replicate the Alpha\_NACustomer\_DF data flow. Name the replicated data flow Alpha\_AuditCustomer\_DF . Add the replicated data flow to a new job, Alpha\_AuditCustomer\_Job . Set up auditing on the data flow Alpha\_AuditCustomer\_DF by adding an audit rule to compare the total number of records in the source and target tables. How to Save all changes and execute the job with auditing enabled and Trace Audit Data set to Yes

- A. To remove the existing audit rule, choose Delete
- B. Choose Add and select Custom .
- C. Right-click the Alpha\_AuditCustomer\_Job and choose Execute .
- D. In the Execution Properties dialog box, in the Execution Options tab, select the Enable auditing checkbox.
- E. In the Trace tab, choose Trace Audit Data .
- F. In the Value field, using the drop down list, change the value to Yes.
