In 18th century France, the masses 1 2 suffered greatly and ate poorly. The main 3 staple of the common diet was bread, and half 4 of the paltry income of the regular French 5 citizen was dedicated to acquiring this simple 6 commodity. As crops failed, shortages 7 occurred, compounding the suffering of the poor. But while the common people suffered in 9 the streets, the privileged classes, cloistered away in opulent mansions, ate and drank luxuriously in their private worlds of wealth 11 12 and pleasure. 13

The stark inequalities of the era did not 14 escape the notice of the poor, and a smoldering 42 resentment built among them, later to be expressed in a conflagration of violence and rebellion. Indeed, the lavish lifestyles of the aristocracy may have had even more to do with the coming of revolution than the troubles of the peasantry.

21 Upon hearing of the agonies of the 22 people, that they had "no bread to eat," Marie 23 Antoinette, then Dauphine and later Queen of France, is reputed to have replied, "Let them 25 eat cake!" The utterance acquired a great 26 symbolic importance in the aftermath of the 27 French Revolution, when historians used it to illustrate the ignorance and indifference of the

upper classes to the suffering of the poor. The 29

30 story expressed the feelings of the people,

spoke clearly and powerfully to the sentiment 31

32 of the time, and agreed with the judgment of

33 the Revolutionary Tribunal that the Dauphine

was a traitor to the people - a judgment which 34

would lead her to the guillotine. It is an

excellent tale, but it does have one minor flaw: 36

it is almost certainly not true. 37

> It is, at the very least, a misattribution, but very likely a total fabrication. It appeared first in Confessions, the autobiography of Jean-Jacques Rousseau, attributed only to a "great princess." Rousseau's Confessions was not noted for its reliability, and even if we take the tale to be true, it would almost certainly have been written while Marie Antoinette was still only a small child.

46 47 Alas, a good story's survival rarely rests on whether or not it actually happened. This 48 49 tale has survived the Queen as one of the most widely acknowledged "facts" of her life, and it 50 51 is likely to persist, marching down into history, 52 bearing with it the spirit of an age - and 53 followed always by a chorus of historical pedants, chanting persistently, "But of course, 54

55 it isn't true."




