QUESTION 3

You have a Microsoft 365 subscription that uses Microsoft Teams and contains a Microsoft 365 group named Group1.

The Subscription has the Teams policy shown in the following exhibit:

You need to ensure that the members of Group1 can create private channels. The solution must use the principle of least privilege. What should you do first?

- A. Create a team template.
- B. Modify the Teams settings for the subscription.

- D. Create a Teams policy that has Create private channels set to On.

Correct Answer: D

As an admin, you can use policies in Microsoft Teams to control what users in your organization can do in teams and channels. For example, you can set whether users are allowed to create private or shared channels.

You manage teams policies by going to Teams > Teams policies in the Microsoft Teams admin center. You can use the global (Org-wide default) policy or create and assign custom policies. Users in your organization will automatically get the

global policy unless you create and assign a custom policy.

Note, step 2: You can assign a policy directly to users, either individually or at scale through a batch assignment (if supported for the policy type), or to a group that the users are members of (if supported for the policy type).

Sales site.



Solution: From the Microsoft Teams client, you create a new team and select Create from an existing Office 365 group or team. Does this meet the goal?

The Sales SharePoint site will have an associated Office 365 group. We need to create a new Team from that group. That will ensure that any new channels created in the new Team will create a new folder in the Sales SharePoint site.
