Box 1: Co-owner

Manage the properties of cloud flow A.

You must be the creator or owner to add or remove owners from a cloud flow.



Any owner of a cloud flow can perform these actions:

View the run history.

Manage the properties of the flow (for example, start or stop the flow, add owners, or update credentials for a connection).

Edit the definition of the flow (for example, add or remove an action or condition).

Add or remove other owners (but not the flow's creator).

Delete the flow.

Box 2: Run-only

Manually trigger cloud flow B.

The run-only permissions feature allows you to grant a very limited set of permissions to manually-triggered flows (such as button and instant flows). With this option, users can only execute the flow. They cannot edit or modify any part of the

flow and will only be granted permission to trigger it.

Incorrect:

* Microsoft Power Platform Admin

If you're an Environment Admin, Global admin, or Power Platform admin, you can manage the flows created in your organization.

Admins can do the following from the Power Platform admin center:

View flow details, connections, and owners Share the flow with others Disable the flow Delete the flow

QUESTION 3

Timer control Duration property – How long a timer runs in milliseconds. The maximum is 24 hours expressed in milliseconds. Default is 60 seconds.

Note: Timer control in Power Apps

A control that can determine how your app responds after a certain amount of time passes.

Description

Timers can, for example, determine how long a control appears or change other properties of a control after a certain amount of time has passed.

Note:

In Power Apps Studio, timers run only in Preview mode.

Key properties

Duration – How long a timer runs in milliseconds. The maximum is 24 hours expressed in milliseconds. Default is 60 seconds.

OnTimerEnd – Actions to perform when a timer finishes running.

Repeat – Whether a timer automatically restarts when it finishes running.

The Barcode scanner control for canvas apps scans barcodes, QR codes, and data-matrix codes on an Android or iOS device.
