QUESTION 3

Moose is the most important game animal in Alaska.

- B. Moose are the most important game animal in Alaska
- C. Moose, the most important game animal in Alaska
- D. Mooses are the most important game animal in Alaska
- E. Moose have the most important game animal in Alaska

Correct Answer: B

This sentence has an error in the verb that follows a plural noun `moose\\'.

Option "Moose is the most important game animal in Alaska" uses a singular verb (is) in the place of a



plural verb.

Option "Moose, the most important game animal in Alaska" does not have any verb.

Option "Mooses are the most important game animal in Alaska" uses a wrong plural form of the noun (mooses).

Option "Moose have the most important game animal in Alaska" uses an auxiliary verb (have) without a main verb.

Option "Moose are the most important game animal in Alaska" uses a plural verb 'are'. That is appropriate with (he) noun; hence, it is the correct answer.
