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QUESTION 1

When creating a new profile, the administrator tried to create a partition for future expansion by including more memory than was available on the machine. Which of the following is the most likely result of this action?

QUESTION 2

The backup system administrator sees an entry in the error log for a disk error for an internal SCSI disk. The error log is identifying this disk at the following location code U1.9-P1/Z2-09. What is the exact location of the disk in the machine?

- A. First I/O drawer, first planar, second disk pack, second disk
- B. First I/O drawer first planar, first disk pack, first disk
- C. Second I/O drawer, first planar, second disk pack, second disk
- D. Second I/O drawer second planar, first disk pack, first disk

QUESTION 3

The LEDs in AIX are often used to diagnose boot failure. When the p690 is in LPAR mode, how can the partition LEDs be viewed?

A. Assign the Operating Panel of the p690 to the desired partition.

- B. Open a virtual terminal window to view the LEDs on the partition.
- C. Select an active partition profile on the HMC and the operator panel will display the LED for that partition.
- D. Open the "Partition Management Screen" on the HMC and the LEDs for each of the partitions will be displayed.

QUESTION 4

Which of the following options may NOT be used to install AIX system maintenance (PTFs) in a partitioned



environment?

- A. Use NIM to install the PTF images to the partition over the network.
- B. Use the \\'Software Maintenance\\' function of the HMC to install the PTFs.
- C. Allocate the CD-ROM device to the partition and install from the PTF media.
- D. Use smitty update_all from a common NFS mount point containing the bffcreated PTF images.

QUESTION 5

Which of the following performance monitoring tools are available on the POWER4 LPAR system platform for a system administrator to use?

- A. truss, topas, symon and iostat

- D. svmon, analyze, vmstat and truss

QUESTION 7

What should be done to change resources in an active LPAR?

A. Modify the resource definitions while the partition is active. The changes will take effect when the partition is deactivated by AIX with a shutdown -Fr.

B. Deactivate the partition with the AIX shutdown -F. Modify the resource definitions and activate the profile.



C. Deactivate the partition by using a soft reset from the pull-down menu. Modify the resource definitions and activate the profile.

D. Modify the resource definition while the partition is active. Activate the profile with the AIX shutdown -F.

QUESTION 8

A customer has an 8-way POWER4 p650 system. They have one partition running AIX 5.2, two partitions running AIX 5.1, and one partition running Linux. What is the procedure to move processors between partitions?

A. Create new profiles on the HMC for the partitions to be moved. The new profiles will be dynamically activated.

B. Create new profiles on the HMC for the partitions to be moved. Shut down both currently active profiles. Manually select and activate the new profiles.

C. Use the graphical user interface or command-line function of the HMC to dynamically move the resources from any of the partitions to the AIX 5.2 partition.

D. Use the graphical user interface or command-line function of the HMC to dynamically move the resources from one of the AIX 5.1 partitions to the AIX 5.2 partition.

QUESTION 9

A system administrator wants to move the media drawer CD-ROM on a p670 dynamically between two active partitions using the HMC. What steps are required to perform this task?

A. 1) From HMC select Dynamic Reconfiguration window, click move 2) Select group U1.1.9-P1-I5 for CD-ROM 3) Select to and from in Dynamic Reconfiguration, click move

B. 1) From HMC select Dynamic Reconfiguration window, click move 2) Select group U1.18-P1-I10 for CD-ROM 3) Select to and from in Dynamic Reconfiguration, click move

C. 1) From HMC select Dynamic Reconfiguration window, click move 2) Select group 128 for CD-ROM location 3) Select to and from in Dynamic Reconfiguration, click move

D. 1) From HMC select Dynamic Reconfiguration window, click move 2) Select group 128 slot 5 for the CD-ROM location 3) Select to and from in Dynamic Reconfiguration, click move

QUESTION 10



A p690 system is configured with three LPARs, which are all in a running state. The system administrator has created an additional profile (profileX) for LPAR2 and needs to make this the running profile. Which of the following actions need to be followed?

- A. Issue shutdown -F in LPAR2 and activate profileX
- B. Issue a soft reset command in LPAR2
- C. Issue shutdown -Fr in LPAR2 and activate profileX
- D. Choose deactivate LPAR2 and reactivate LPAR2 with profileX

QUESTION 11

Which of the following must be considered when initially installing the 64-bit AIX kernel into a partition?

- A. 32-bit applications must be recompiled to run in this mode
- B. The base filesystems for rootvg will be the Journaled FileSystem 2 (JFS2)
- C. Switching back to a 32-bit kernel requires reinstallation of the partition
- D. If one partition contains a 64-bit kernel, then all partitions must have the 64-bit kernel

QUESTION 12

The HMC has 5 user access (authority) levels, which include Operator, Advanced Operator, User Administrator, Service Representative and System Administrator. The Advanced Operator can perform which of the following tasks?

- A. Change user passwords
- B. Add and delete HMC users
- C. Delete profiles and partitions
- D. Create, activate and reset partitions
