To use the Web Client to back up and restore files on a remote client system, you must have an administrative user ID with client access authority over the node name for the remote client system.

Correct Answer: B

The Tivoli Storage Manager GUI must be run from the X Window System. If you see the Tivoli Storage Manager icon on your desktop, Tivoli Storage Manager is already running. Double-click the icon to open the Tivoli Storage Manager window. If the Tivoli Storage Manager icon does not appear on your desktop, you should start Tivoli Storage Manager using the dsmj (starts the JavaTM GUI) command.

QUESTION 3

Which log records the sessions of the web client?

- A. webcli.log
- B. adsmweb.log
- C. tsmwebcl.log
- D. dsmwebcl.log

Correct Answer: D



All Web client messages are written to the Web client log file, dsmwebcl.log.

QUESTION 4

What does the message ANR***W format indicate?

Correct Answer: D

Server ANR messages list. Examples:

ANR0107W: Source file(line number): Transaction transaction ID was not committed due to an internal error.

ANR0115W: The server script script name attempted to start more parallel commands than are allowed for a single script. A single script is limited to parallel command limit parallel commands. ANR0116W: The server script script name attempted to start more parallel commands than are allowed for the server. The server is limited to parallel command limit parallel commands.

QUESTION 5

Which two statements describe the process of collocation?

- A. Placing IBM Tivoli Storage Manager (TSM) database volumes in the same directories.
- B. Isolating archive and backup data to separate storage pools.

When collocation is by client node Volume selection order: 1st: A volume that already contains files from the same client node

*

When collocation is by file space Volume selection order: 1st: A volume that already contains files from the same file space of that client node

Note: With collocation enabled, the server attempts to keep files belonging to a group of client nodes, a single client



node, or client file space on a minimal number of sequential-access storage volumes. Collocation reduces the number of volume mounts required when users restore, retrieve, or recall a large number of files from the storage pool. Collocation thus reduces the amount of time required for these operations.

QUESTION 6

Which option meets the requirement to provide online snapshot backups for an enterprise Oracle database?

QUESTION 7

Correct Answer: C

The Backup Operators group allows users to back up and restore files regardless of whether they have read or write access to the files. Since this group has a limited set of user rights, some functions are not available to members of the Backup Operators group.

QUESTION 8

What is the purpose of the set access command?

- A. It enables the client for restore.
- B. It allows the user to perform cross client restore.
- C. It allows the administrator to perform client actions.
- D. It allows clients to communicate with the IBM Tivoli Storage Manager server.



Correct Answer: B

The set access command gives users at other nodes access to your backup versions or archived copies. You can give another user access to a specific file, multiple files, or all files in a directory. When you give access to another user, that user can restore or retrieve your objects. Specify in the command whether you are giving access to archives or backups.

QUESTION 9

What is left on the client disk when a file is migrated using IBM Tivoli Storage Manager space management?

- A. a mig file
- B. a stub file
- C. no file is left
- D. a directory file

Correct Answer: B

When a file is migrated from your local system to Tivoli Storage Manager storage, a placeholder, or stub file, is created in place of the original file. Stub files contain the necessary information to recall your migrated files and remain on your local file system so that the files appear to reside locally. This contrasts with archiving, where you usually delete files from your local file system after archiving them.

QUESTION 10

What is the purpose of the command, validate lanfree?

- A. verify the LANFree mount points
- B. verify the target disk storage pools
- C. verify the LANFree storage agent is installed
- D. verify LANFree configuration is working properly

Correct Answer: D

VALIDATE LANFREE (Validate LAN-Free paths)

Use this command to determine which destinations for a given node using a specific storage agent are capable of LAN-Free data movement.

Example:

Command

validate lanfree tiger aix_sta1
```
